Rosebank


### Directions:

#### **From O.R. Tambo Airport**

- Take the R24 towards Johannesburg
- Follow N3/N12 South signs
- Take M2 West towards Johannesburg
- Take M1 North towards Sandton/Pretoria
- Exit at Glenhove Road (after 11th Avenue off ramp)
- Turn left at the traffic lights and continue for approximately 3km
- Cross over the intersection at Oxford Road onto Bolton Road
- At the Third Traffic light turn right into Sturdee Avenue
- The Hotel is at the Corner of Sturdee & Tyrwhitt Avenue on your right (entrance on Sturdee)

## Cape Town:

### Directions to Parking:

- 1) Exit Airport and Head South
- 2) At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto Airport Approach Road
- 3) Keep right to stay on Airport Approach Road
- 4) Merge onto Settlers Way / N2 via the ramp to Cape Town
- 5) Merge onto De Waal Drive / N2
- 6) Continue onto Nelson Mandela Boulevard
- 7) Take the Oswald Pirow Street exit toward Heerengracht Street
- 8) Merge onto Hertzog Boulevard
- 9) Turn left onto Heerengracht Street
- 10) At the roundabout, take the 3rd exit onto Hans Strijdom Avenue
- 11) Turn left onto Long Street
- 12) Turn left onto Strand Street
- 13) Turn left into: **Parking, Strand Street, Shop no: 16B, Lower Level**
- 14) Utilize Parking Spaces from Level 4 and above**
- 15) Level 1-3 is private parking (delegates will be clamped if they park here)

### Parking Ticket Instructions:

1. Delegates will receive a parking ticket from Karabo Parkade (they need to keep this ticket)
2. The Hotel will give another ticket either at registration or on departure
3. This ticket will be used as payment for the first ticket
4. Once the delegate has left the hotel, they will go to the **PAY STATION** at Karabo Parkade
5. They will insert the first ticket into the pay station following with the ticket given by the hotel
6. The pay station will accept it as payment and will return the initial ticket
7. If there are any issues press help at the pay station

**NB: Please do not throw the first ticket away and do not swap it for the second ticket – they go hand in hand**

Directions:

From the Airport:

- From Airport take N2 to Durban - Take off ramp to join M41
- Take off ramp onto Umhlanga Rocks Drive (M12) and turn left.
- Continue down to 2nd traffic circle and turn left into Centenary Boulevard.
- Drive down the road and turn right into Aurora – the Garden Court Umhlanga hotel is then on your left.

### ***How will I be able to catch up on a workshop should I miss it for whatever reason?***

Should you happen to miss a workshop you have paid for, please advise us as soon as possible. All workshops will be recorded, and you will be able to view it via Panopto. You will still earn your CPD points if you complete the syndicate work.

***I am a Physio/OT/Nurse. What if some of the workshops do not apply to me?***

This series of workshops is part of a three-year training in medico-legal practice, designed to make you a more rounded medico-legal expert, able to understand and interact with all the other disciplines involved in medico-legal practice. To get the full benefit and recognition for the training, attendance of all workshops is essential.

You will find the Outcome and Framework document of the workshops on the SAMLA website. These show what the planned workshops are really about and what the relevance will be to various disciplines. For “Quantum experts”, the relevance of the TBI workshop, for example, is stated as “to evaluate the factual and scientific bases, as well as the reasoning processes, of opposing neurosurgeons or neurologists who express differing opinions, and to form a reasoned view on which is the more natural and consistent with objective test findings and actual performance in the laboratory of life.” We have had numerous requests from quantum experts on how to deal with the opinion of a medical specialist which is manifestly wrong and inconsistent with objective test findings. This, and other equally important issues will be dealt with in the workshops.

You are free to attend selected workshops of your choice. In that case you will receive the CPD points pertaining to the specific workshop as well as a certificate from UCT for attendance or completion of each workshop, will not qualify for the full course recognition.

The purpose of SAMLA is to provide a platform for intellectual discourse between members of different disciplines in the medico-legal arena, and to provide high quality ethical training where a need exists.

The training offered by the SAMLA Faculty to date has been multidisciplinary.

However, Physios, OTs and others have always been, and still are, welcome to form discipline-specific subgroups of SAMLA and/or of the SAMLA Faculty, and those subgroups may develop and provide discipline-specific training, but not in the current course.

We hope you will be inspired to join us and lift your career as a medico-legal expert to new heights.
